The city of Helsingborg

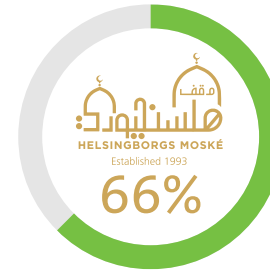
Helsingborg is located on the southwest coast of Sweden with a population of 150 thousand, The Muslim community in Helsingborg is growing steadily, with over 15 thousand residents practicing of which belong to the Islamic faith. Considering the limited number of facilities available for the growing population of Muslims in the city, there is now a critical need for a dedicated center to cater to their spiritual, educational, and social needs.

Project Overview

- Established in 1993, the Helsingborg Mosque Wakf is the city's largest Islamic organization with over 2000 members. They have fostered strong relationships with local authorities and other Islamic centers across the country, demonstrating their commitment to collaboration and community integration.
- Through collaborative efforts, the Wakf secured approval and purchased a 10,000 m² plot of land for the project. The planned Islamic Center will occupy 3,600 m² of this space.
- This long awaited opportunity for the Muslim community in Helsingborg and its suburbs spurred the development of a comprehensive plan to secure the necessary resources.

Phases of the project

Approximately 66% of the whole project has been completed. The Wakf has been inaugurated and is being used for all the prayers and the various religious, social, and youth activities.



- Phase 1**
Purchase of the land and acquisition of all the necessary permits, architectural plans, and preparation of the infrastructure.
Completed; beginning of 2023
- Phase 2**
Construction of the commercial facility and preparing the ground floor as a temporary prayer hall and the second floor as a school for teaching the Quran and the Arabic language in addition to shared office space for rental.
Completed; beginning of 2024
- Phase 3**
Construction of the Mosque building and completion of the whole project.
Expected Completion; end of 2025

Importance of the project

The accelerated increase of Muslims in the area. This increase is caused by several factors including the new migrants, second and third generation Muslims, and the newly converted Muslims who have embraced the Islamic faith.

The need for a center that correctly represents the Islamic faith and can harness the energy of the young Muslim youth. The lack of such centers can lead to the wrongful placement of the energy of the youth leading them to a life that negatively impacts them and the society they live in.

The political scene in Sweden is gradually moving to the extreme right wing which threatens the existence and wellbeing of the Religious freedom in Sweden. Thus, owning the buildings in which we use may secure a place for future generations to practice their faith.

Cost of the project

The project is estimated to cost a total of 65 million Swedish Krona. So far, 42 million Swedish Krona have been raised from Sweden and the surrounding areas.

- Area: 1600 m² (two floors)
- Cost: 18 million SEK
- Currently used for prayer and worship
- Status: **Complete**

The Land and Infrastructure

- Area: 10,000 m²
- Cost: 8 million SEK
- Status: **Complete**

The Mosque Building

- Area: 1920 m²
- Capacity: 1400 worshippers (men and women)
- Estimated Cost: 32 million SEK
- Status: **Under construction**
